Feed Caterpillars with Host Plants

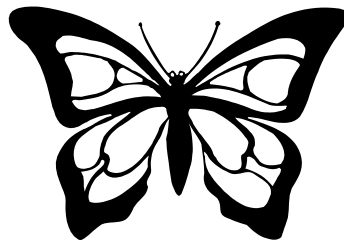


Caterpillar Host

Silver Checkerspot	<i>Sunflowers</i>
Carolina Sphinx Moth (Hornworm)	<i>Tomato Tobacco</i>
Eastern Tailed Blue	<i>Legumes</i>
Least Skipper	<i>Grasses</i>
Luna Moth	<i>Various Trees</i>

Create a Beneficial Environment

- Choose a sunny spot
- Create mass plantings
- Use long flowering plants
- Provide a variety of flowering nectar plants
- Provide a variety of host plants
- Employ fragrant flowers
- Provide wind breaks
- Provide resting/hiding places
- Provide shallow water for puddling
- Provide fruit tray
- Stop using pesticides
